ATAC Solutions has a zero tolerance approach to slavery and is committed to preventing acts of slavery and human trafficking from occurring within its business and supply chain, and imposes those same high standards on our contractors, suppliers and other interested parties.

ATAC Solutions specialises in the development and marketing of equipment for the treatment of municipal and industrial water. Great emphasis is always placed on the development of new products which are at the forefront of environmental technology. Our works and operations are based mainly in the South East of England and utilise a wide range of local manufacturing companies and specialist suppliers and contractors.

We have;

- Made our staff aware of the Modern Slavery Act, including its definitions of slavery and human trafficking,
- Told staff what to do if they suspect a case of slavery or human trafficking,
- Contacted suppliers and partners in potentially higher risk categories to check what assurance arrangements they have in place,
- Commenced a revision of our procurement contracts and related documents to include prohibitions in respect of slavery and human trafficking and compliance with legislation and;
- Review of our Whistleblowing Policy.

The above procedures are designed to;

- Identify and assess potential risk areas in our business and supply chains,
- Reduce the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in our business and supply chains,
- Monitor potential risk areas in our business and supply chains,
- Provide adequate protection for whistle blowers.

This statement is pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our Company Slavery and Human Trafficking statement for the current year.
